During Open House, students will report to Alpha Homeroom to pick up a draft schedule in order find your classrooms and meet teachers (Alpha Homeroom lists will be posted around the school). A list of *general supplies* can be found on our website and some teachers may request specific additional materials.

**DRAFT schedules** will be available for viewing starting Wednesday, July 19<sup>th</sup> via your FOCUS portal (<http://focus.leeschools.net>). IF NO SCHEDULE IS AVAILABLE FOR VIEWING, please call the school to schedule an appointment with your counselor. If there is a question concerning the schedule, or if it is necessary to make a correction, please visit our website and complete a Back to School Schedule Review Form (<https://goo.gl/forms/uP6rkzDU8IIJ2JEK2>) so your counselor may review your schedule and make necessary adjustments. Once adjustments are made or should a counselor need further information they will contact you for a phone or personal conference.

Please try to take care of any scheduling issue by completing the Back to School Schedule Review form as soon as possible. Counselors will be available for appointments regarding schedules from July 24<sup>th</sup> – August 9<sup>th</sup>. Changes will not be made after the start of school unless it meets one of the following criteria:

1. An error or a missing class
2. Dual-enrollment class concern
3. Duplicate or repeat class on schedule
4. Class needed for graduation is omitted or was completed over summer

Due to the high number of specialty course offerings, scheduling limitations, and state expectations on class size, requests for classes to be taken at a different time period during the day are **unable** to be addressed.

**On the first day of school**, students will report to their ALPHA HOMEROOM as soon as they arrive. Lists of ALPHA HOMEROOMS will be posted throughout the school to assist students in finding their homerooms. In ALPHA HOMEROOM, students will receive a final copy of their first semester schedule. It may reflect changes due to administrative leveling of classes or other changes in classes or personnel. This will be the official and final schedule.
