Personal Statement & Headshot

- Include a recent headshot of yourself. This will help us connect the artist to the art work.
- Write a personal statement of 500 words or less describing your previous art/photography training and your personal interest in the fine arts or the goals that you hope to accomplish as a Photography student over the next four years. Include this statement with your digital portfolio.

Digital Portfolio

Total of 10 images. Images can both be edited or unedited. Please provide the following 4 required artworks in the portfolio, the remaining 6 works will be judged for ambition levels, understanding of basic principles and elements of design, and creative thought processes. Images should be placed in a Google Slide Presentation or PPT

10 Images should include:

- 1 Color Image
- 1 B&W Image
- 1 Portrait (can be of anyone)
- 1 Self Portrait (can be a creative selfie)
- Remaining 6 images of your choice

A Note About Your Images:

- Phone pictures are perfectly acceptable
- Edited or unedited is fine too
- Self Portrait can be a selfie- no snapchat filters please
- I'm looking for "how" you see/arrange things visually- not technical ability


